- coach teams, join clubs and escort field trips

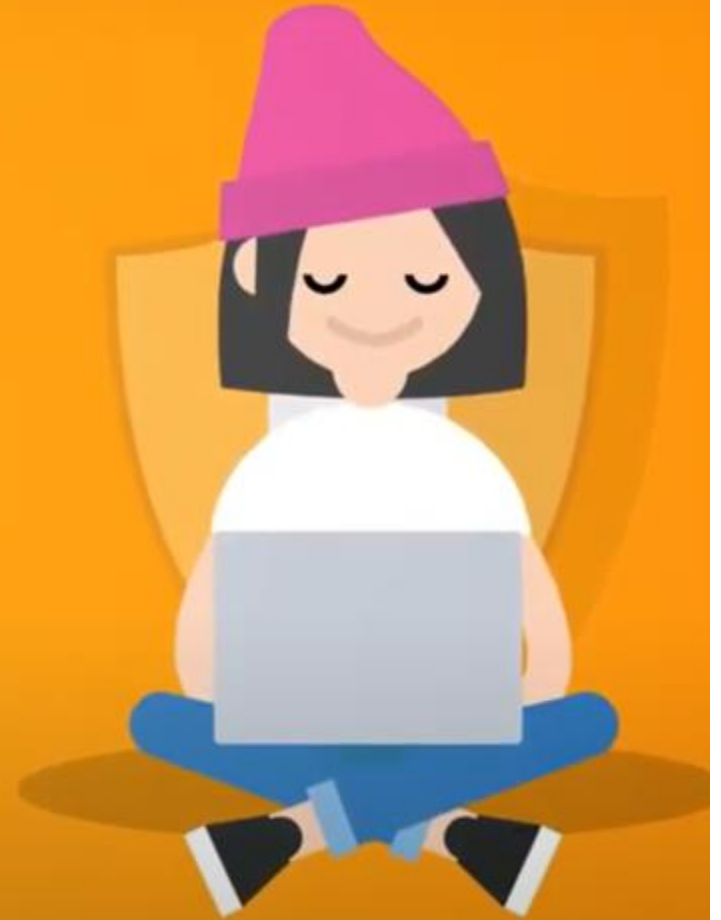

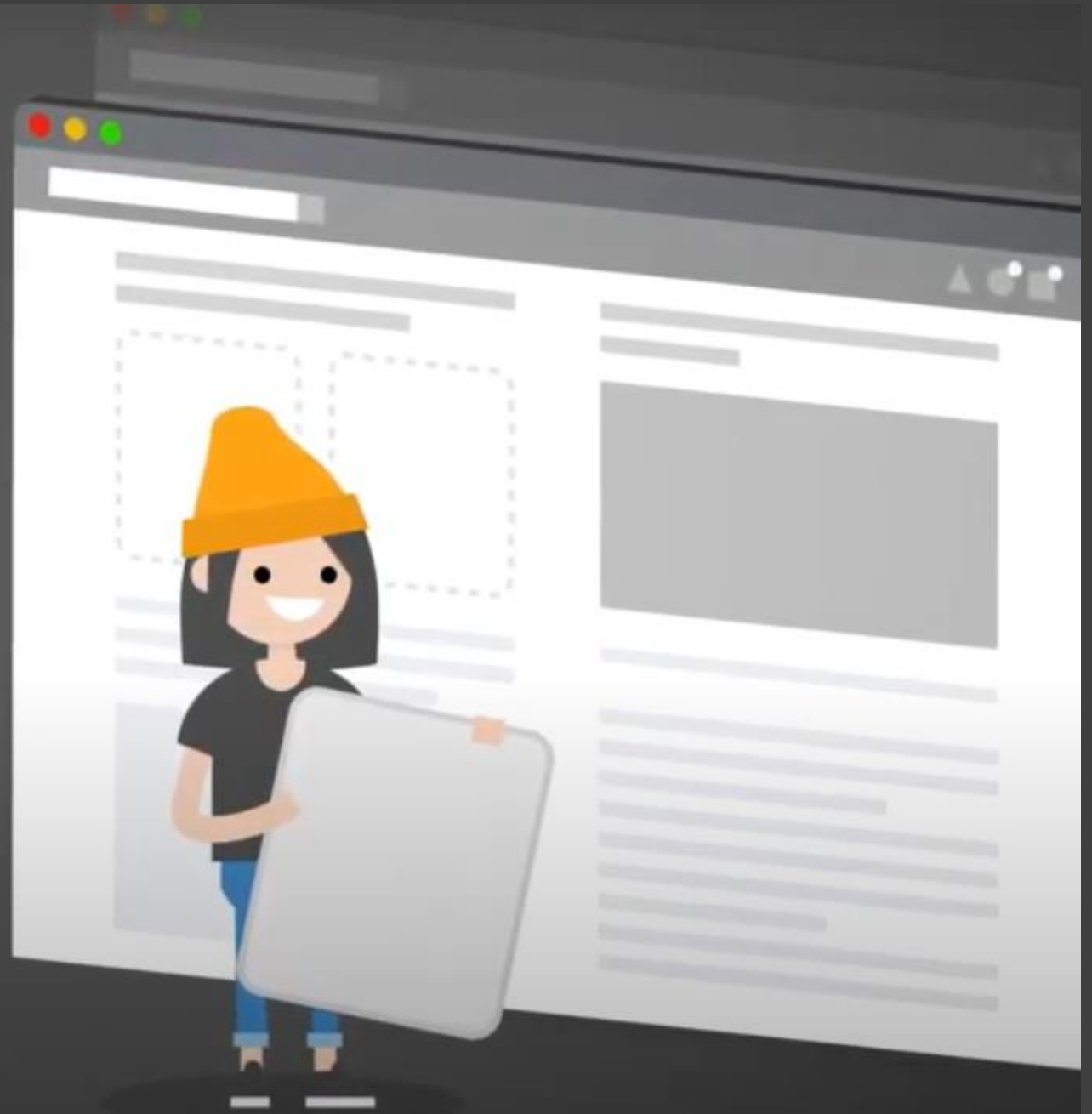

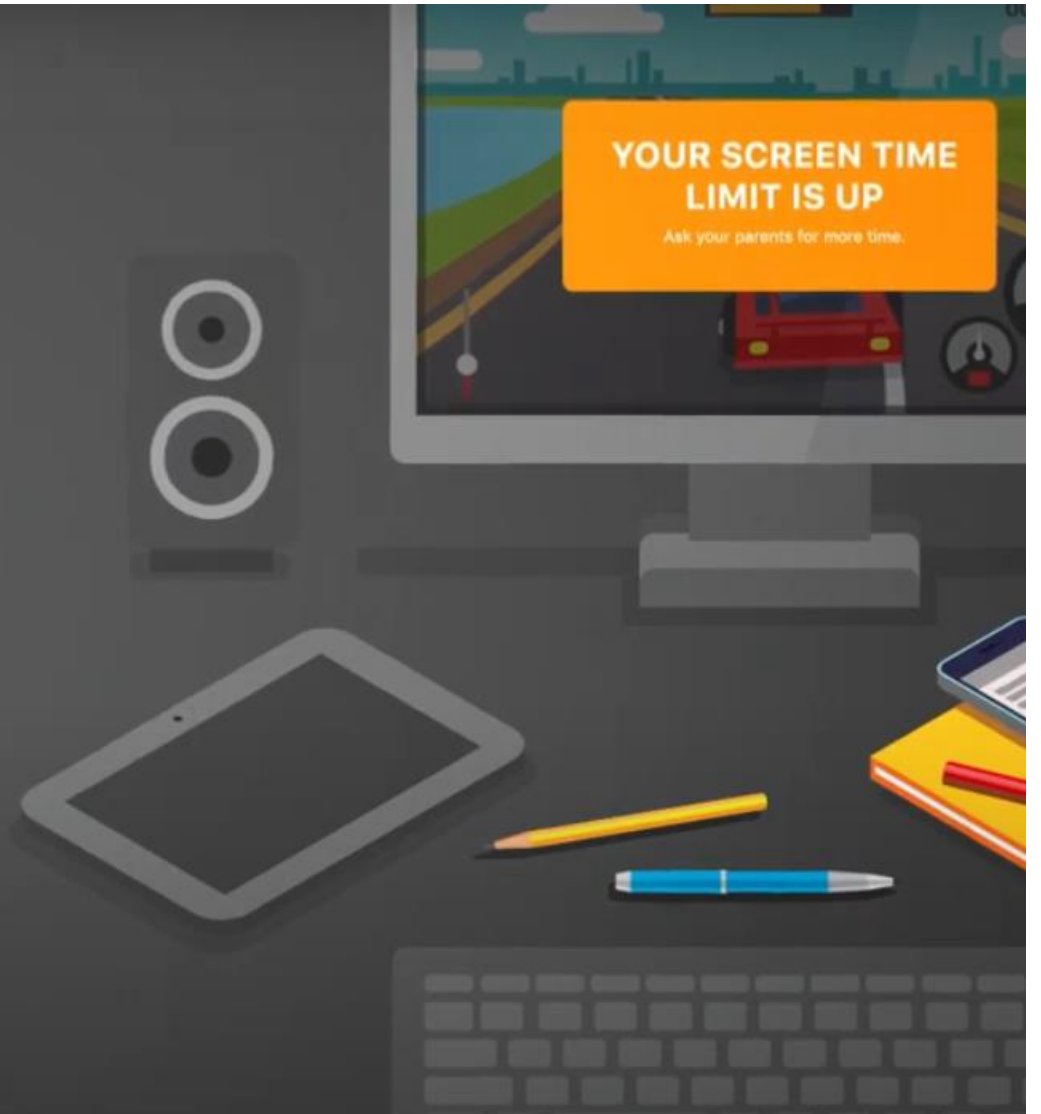
