Thursday afternoon: noon – 3 p.m.

- Blow up mini-balloons with hand pumps
- Blow up 175 inflatable prizes with air compressor
- Blow up large balloons with air compressor
- Tie groups of 3 large balloons with ribbon
- Cut 85 tablecloths from rolls
- Tape tablecloths to tables
- Lay out games – take out of PAC storage
- Put game posters with games
- Brew coffee in large urn for iced coffee
- Juice drinks & waters in lunchroom fridges
- Yogurt containers filled with water and frozen

Friday morning : 9 – 11 a.m.

- Drop off baked goods for bake sale TABLE at OFFICE
- Gr. 7 parents: Drop off CAKE WALK cakes to the GYM
- Drivers from 9 – 9:30 get silent auction items
- Help sort and organize the silent auction items
- Cannisters – label and tape up the tops
- Place arrows on wooden posts
- Finish taping tablecloths to tables
- Take all food items from PAC storage to lunchroom

Friday afternoon: 1 – 2:45 GO TIME – WE NEED 25 PEOPLE

FAIR SET UP:

- Set up the games outside, Bottle Trombola game in gym
- Set up all 6 tents (4 people needed for each set up) 1 – 1:30
- Tie up groups of 3 balloons as décor around game area
- Put up barrier tape for games area and prize table area
- Put up all the posters for all the stations/games
- Help set up the silent auction area (1:30 – 2:45 commitment)

FOOD SET UP:

- Move food/drinks from PAC storage to kitchen
- Put large pots of water on to boil for hotdogs in kitchen
- Food people prep – help get things cooking! (1 – 2:45)
- Rice cooker helpers: rinse rice and put in rice cookers
- Help sort and organize all the food (cafeteria tables)
- Put ice and juices in coolers

Friday: between 4 and 8 p.m.

- For 30 minutes relieve a volunteer parent for a dinner break

Friday evening: 8 – 8:30 TAKE DOWN - WE NEED 20 PEOPLE

- Tables and all chairs back in the gym stacked
- All game signs taken down and stored in gym
- Take everything down and clean up garbage from grounds
